I joined Gathinga primary school from 1966 to 1974 when I did my C.P.E. exam and passed to join Federal High school in 1975. I later transferred to Tabaya Sec. School.

WORK:

On 1st July 1979, I joined the Ministry of Works as a trainee on plant machines. The course took six years. Later I took a specialized course on fuel injection.

I also took another course on computerized diagnostics on motor equipment at Bosch.

I retired from the then Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure On 30th June 2019.

HOBBIES:

At a young age I enjoyed swimming, football, photography /video shooting, editing and programming; an area which almost developed to becoming a career. I also ventured into the Matatu industry.

FAMILY LIFE:

On 3rd December 1994, I married my love, the late Grace Wairimu and we were blessed with two lovely daughters; Stella Wambui and Sharon Nyambura.

CHURCH:

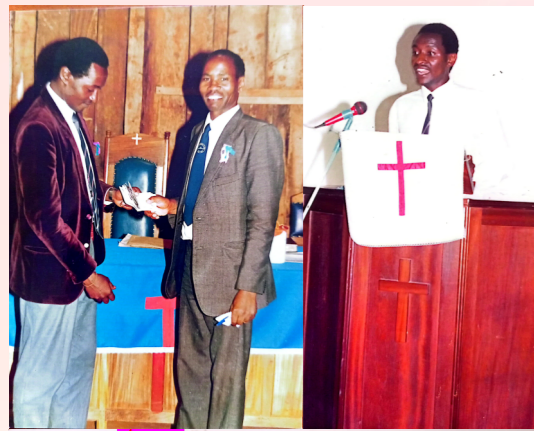

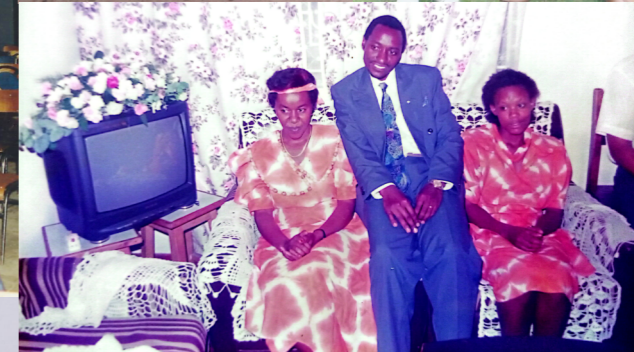
